Originally a small residential tree service and firewood sales company, the business blossomed into a full spectrum vegetation management business that specializes in providing services to a variety of customers including federal, state and local agencies, municipalities, utility companies, timber companies, small landowners, and fire safe councils.

For the last 7 years, we have been a contractor for PG&E and WAPA for the trimming and removal of trees and brush near primary distribution lines (those carrying between 4,000 volts to 21,000 volts) and transmission lines (those carrying between 60,000 volts to 500,000 volts). We contract with these power providers so that their distribution and transmission lines will comply with local, regional and state laws for the safety of the public to eliminate potential fire hazards, and to increase electric service reliability.


